

# Getting Started With GoAnywhere Command Connector

The GoAnywhere Command Connector allows you to use GoAnywhere Command's automate actions to run projects, add users, manage keys, and more.

## Step 1: Configure the GoAnywhere Command Connector

Follow the instructions on the Cloud Connector Resource topic to add a GoAnywhere Command Connector.

**NOTE:**

Before configuring the resource, verify the permissions of the Admin User that will be used to log into GoAnywhere MFT. For example, if the Admin User in the GoAnywhere Command Connector Resource does not have the Key Manager role, any actions that need the Key Manager role permissions will not be available in the GoAnywhere Command Connector.

On the GoAnywhere Command Connector, specify the following fields.

- **Name** - A name for the Cloud Connector Resource.
- **Description** - A short paragraph that describes the resource. The description is optional.
- **Cloud Connector** - The name of the Cloud Connector.
- **URL** - The URL of the GoAnywhere MFT server. For example:  
https://10.1.4.1:8001/goanywhere
- **User** - The Admin User name for logging in to GoAnywhere MFT.
- **Password** - The password for the Admin User account.

Select the **Save** button to save the GoAnywhere Command Connector Resource.

## Step 2: Configure the GoAnywhere Project

GoAnywhere Command Connector actions are added to a Project like other file transfer tasks. Use the following instructions to use a GoAnywhere Command Connector action in a Project workflow.

1. From within the Project Designer page, expand the **Cloud Connectors** folder in the **Component Library**, expand the **GoAnywhere Command Connector** menu, and then drag the **Delete Web User** action to the Project Outline.
2. On the Delete Web User action, specify a value for the following fields:
  - **GoAnywhere Command Connector Resource** - A pre-configured GoAnywhere Command Connector Resource from the drop-down list.
  - **User Name** - The Web User account name.
